'Royal Star' is a popular cultivar that has slightly larger and showier flowers than the species. The fragrant white flowers (3-4" diameter), appear before the bright green foliage emerges, about 2 weeks later than the species.

Best grown in full to partial sun, in moist, well-drained, humitic soil.
