'Triple Crown' Thornless Blackberry is named for its three attributes; flavor, productivity and vigor. No catchy ring for more, but this very hardy variety also offers disease resistance and very large berries. Semi-erect, the canes can be trellised or pruned to be free standing in Summer, to an easy picking height.

Best fruit in the full sun with regular water & good drainage.
