# Jubilee

'Jubilee' needs around 500 chill hours for fruit production. It has a very fresh, sweet flavor, ripening over a two week period, May into June. It tolerates some of the harshest growing conditions – heavier soils, hot Summers, and sudden, Winter cold. Self pollinating but better fruiting when interplanted with other Southern Highbush varieties such as 'Misty, or 'O'Neil'.

Yellow and burgundy Fall foliage.

Full sun with regular water and fertility.

Very wildlife friendly.

Very pollinator friendly.
