'Summer Royal' is a vigorous, deciduous, woody, vine, with bold-textured, green foliage. It is grown for its large clusters of big, black, delicious fruit. Summer Royal has a strong Muscat flavor that is sweet, firm to the touch, and ideal to market as a dessert table grape. Ripens early season.

Best fruiting in full sun, in well drained soil, but tolerates light shade & heavier soils. Good drainage is a must, and protection from harsh winds.

Relatively wildlife & drought tolerant after establishment.

Very pollinator & wildlife friendly.
