'Prince Charles' is a vigorous, but compact grower, producing an abundance of 4", pale, lilac-blue flowers. Pale yellow anthers and dark foliage accent the blooms nicely.

Bloom best with at least 6 hours sun.

A group 3 Clematis, flowering on new wood into late Summer.

Relatively wildlife resistant.

Pollinator friendly.
