Best grouped or massed in a shrub border. The fruit has a lovely intense flavor that is enjoyed fresh or used for wines, sauces, and preserves.

Prefers well-drained, acid soil. Good in mounded rows or raised beds with wire supports. Avoid waterlogged soils.
