'Glow Sticks' maintains its mounded, slightly spreading habit year-round. For best results, plant in full sun to partial shade. Once established, 'Glow Sticks' is water-saving, and resistant to drought, disease, heat and humidity. Winter hardy USDA Zone 3a-8b.
