



HYDRANGEA QUERCIFOLIA

## *Queen of Hearts*

Selected in 1998, 'Queen of Hearts' is a hybridization of Oak Leaf Hydrangea cultivars 'Snow Queen' and 'Pee Wee'. This showy hydrangea flowers in early summer, approximately seven to ten days later than most oak leaf. Consequently, its blooms last longer into the season. Flowers open white, then slowly age to a deep pink. Foliage is dark green in summer, mahogany-red in the fall. 'Queen of Hearts' habit make it ideal for use in borders, as specimen, in beds, or planted en mass.



**BOTANICAL NAME** -- Hydrangea quercifolia 'Queen of Hearts'

**COMMON NAME** -- Queen of Hearts Oak Leaf Hydrangea

**USDA HARDINESS** -- 5 to 8

**10 YEAR SIZE** -- 6.5'H x 9'W

**HABIT** -- Medium, deciduous, rounded shrub

**CULTURE** -- Full sun to partial shade; acidic soil that is moist but well drained

### **FEATURES**

- Flowers early summer (7-10 days later than most oak leafs)
- 9-inch long inflorescences open white, age to deep pink
- Inflorescences held upright above foliage
- Dark green Summer foliage, turns mahogany red in Fall
