Pink Popcorn®

Introduced by Briggs Nursery, this hardy northern high bush blueberry is a more compact grower than other varieties, and bears pink fruit that ripens early to mid-season. The medium sized, cream to pink berries have a darker pink blush, and offer true blueberry flavor and aroma. At a mature size of 5'H x 5'W, Pink Popcorn® can be planted in rows, or incorporated easily into the landscape, where its leaves offer red fall color. Pink Popcorn® is self-fertile, but will produce a larger crop of berries if planted in proximity to another early season variety. Like all blueberries, Pink Popcorn™ prefers an acidic soil with adequate moisture.

BOTANICAL NAME -- *Vaccinium corymbosum* 'MNPINK1' USPPAF, CPBRA

COMMON NAME -- Pink Popcorn® Blueberry

USDA HARDINESS -- 3 to 7

MATURE SIZE -- 5'H x 5'W at 10 years

HABIT -- Vase shaped

CULTURE -- Acidic soil; even moisture; full sun; approximately 800 chill hours

FEATURES

- Medium sized pink cream to pink berries with darker pink blush
- Early to mid-season producer
- Red fall color
- Self-pollinating
- Best used for edible fruit production and/or ornamental landscape
