## *Deutzia gracilis* 'Nikko'

This graceful, low spreading gem, with gently arching branches and profuse panicles of brilliant, pure white flowers, is well suited for use in small spaces or as a groundcover. Its finely-textured, willow-like leaves turn a deep burgundy in autumn. Excellent for rock gardens and perennial borders, or as a flowering container plant.



## *Deutzia x hybrida* 'Strawberry Fields'

A flamboyant display of showy flowers make this vigorous, compact cultivar, an excellent choice to bring dramatic color to the garden. From May to June, masses of large, fragrant, star-shaped flowers, borne on conical panicles along gracefully arching branches, cover 'Strawberry Fields'. Great for informal hedges, mixed borders or as a foundation.

- **Zones:** USDA 5 to 8
- **Mature Size:** 2'H x 5W
- **Habit:** Deciduous, spreading, flowering shrub
- **Cultivation:** Tolerates many soil types, pH and light conditions; flowers more profusely in full sun with abundant moisture
- **Flowers:** April to early May; profuse panicles of small, pure white flowers



- **Zones:** USDA 5 to 8
- **Mature Size:** 4-6'H x 4-6'W
- **Habit:** Compact, deciduous, flowering shrub
- **Cultivation:** Full sun; easily grown in most garden soils that are moderately fertile and have good drainage
- **Flowers:** May to June; large, star-shaped, pink with white markings; profuse bloomer
