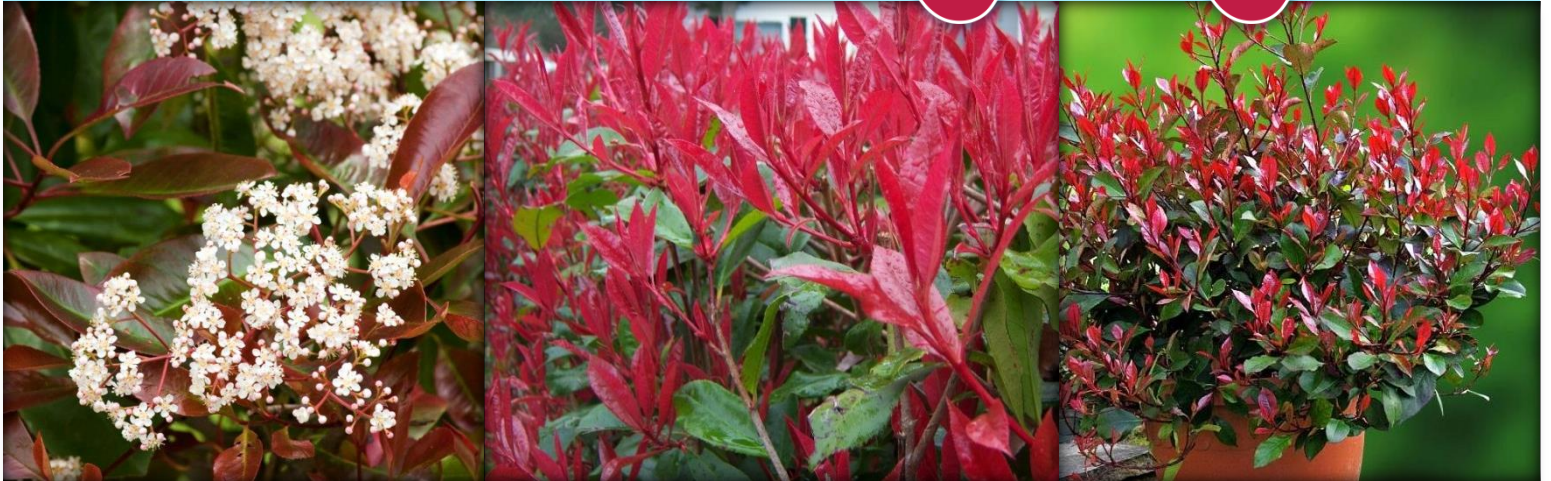




A spectacular shrub featuring glossy green leaves and brilliant red new growth

# PHOTINIA Red Robin



The only Photinia to receive the Royal Horticultural Society Award of Garden Merit (AGM) to date, 'Red Robin' is an improved cultivar of the straight species, *Photinia x fraserii*. It is more compact than its predecessor, and boasts new foliage that is a brighter, more vibrant red color, lasting two to three weeks. 'Red Robin' is also reported to have better resistance to leaf spot, *Entomosporium maculatum*. The leaves mature to leathery, dark green ovals, three to four inches in length. Additional pruning encourages a new flush of red leaves. For best color, and to discourage leaf spot, plant 'Red Robin' in full sun, in a location with good air circulation, and avoid overhead watering.
