The offspring of Syringa x Josee, 'Wishing Star' delights with re-blooming, fragrant pink flowers, and is much more tolerant of colder temperatures than other Syringa cultivars (hardy to USDA zone 4). Its compact form, and resistance to disease and pests, make 'Wishing Star' ideal for both the smaller home landscape, and commercial applications. Excellent planted in beds, borders, or en mass.

**Habit:** *Open branching deciduous shrub*

**Culture:** *Full sun; slightly acidic to neutral soil; average to below average water*

- *Repeat bloomer flowers spring to fall (remove spent flowers to encourage blooms)*
- *Pest and disease resistant*
- *More tolerant to cold temperatures than other cultivars -- hardy to zone 4!*
