'Golden Tuffet'

Thuja occidentalis 'Golden Tuffet'
Common: Golden Tuffet globe arborvitae
Habit: Dense, pillow-shaped; 3'H x 4'W
Zones: USDA 4 to 8
Attractive, finely-textured, yellow spring foliage, turns golden-orange with hints of lime in the winter.



'Jantar'

Thuja occidentalis 'Jantar' PP#22,296
Common: Golden Emerald arborvitae
Habit: Upright, pyramidal; 8'H x 2'W
Zones: USDA 4 to 8
Upright, narrow arborvitae featuring lacey yellow foliage that matures to a warm amber in the winter.



'Teddy'

Thuja occidentalis 'Teddy'
Common: Teddy Bear globe arborvitae
Habit: Dense, globe-shaped; 2-4'H x 2-4'W
Zones: To USDA 4 to 8
Dwarf conifer with plenty of finely-textured, deep green foliage, forms a neat little ball in the landscape.



'Bobozam'

Thuja occidentalis 'Bobozam'
Common: Silvery Green globe arborvitae
Habit: Dense, globe-shaped; 2-3'H x 2-3'W
Zones: To USDA 4 to 8
The lacey, blue-green foliage of this dwarf cultivar retains its color year round, and is soft to the touch.



'Sienna Sunset™'

Thuja occidentalis 'Anniek' PP#22,813
Common: Sienna Sunset™ globe arborvitae
Habit: Dwarf, globe-shaped; 3'H x 4'W
Zones: To USDA 4 to 8
From spring through mid-fall, the foliage is a warm shade of gold, then burnishes bronze in the winter.



'Fire Chief™'

Thuja occidentalis 'Congabe' PP#19,009
Common: Fire Chief™ globe arborvitae
Habit: Compact, rounded; 3-4'H x 3-4'W
Zones: To USDA 4 to 8
Bright golden spring foliage, and fantastically deep red fall color. Plant in a sunny location for more intense color.
