

C BEESIA DELTOPHYLLA

This fabulous evergreen perennial, introduced from China, is perfect for shade gardens! Beesia's veined and dimpled, heart-shaped, evergreen leaves, emerge with a purplish hue, then mature to dark green, with a lacquer-like sheen. Foliage is perched atop dark purplegreen stems, further emphasizing its lustrous green leaves. Summer brings slender, wispy flower spikes, dotted with small, star-shaped white blossoms, that rise above the mounds of glossy foliage. This fuss-free filler prefers rich, well-drained soil, and looks best with regular summer water. It will tolerate full sun with additional watering, but dappled or deep shade is ideal. Lovely when planted in narrow beds, under trees, or in woodland gardens, and pest-resistant to boot!

Common Name – Beesia, White Buttercup **Mature Size** – 1'H x 1.5'W **Hardiness** – USDA zones 5b to 9

Foliage – Evergreen, heart-shaped leaves are heavily veined and glossy, born on purplish-green petioles

Flowers – Small, star-shaped white flowers born on long, slender spikes in Summer
