Unlike its namesake, Nandina domestica, or Heavenly Bamboo, is non-invasive, and remains compact. In shades of fresh green to deep burgundy, with brilliant red berries in the fall, Nandina offers excellent seasonal color for containers, mixed borders, or planted en masse.

### Nandina domestica 'Nansid6' BONFIRE™

PPAF, CPBRAF. Slender, twisty, orange-red new growth distinguishes this fiery new Nandina. Compact habit. Excellent as specimen, planted en masse as an informal, colorful border, or in larger mixed containers. 3'H x 3'W. USDA zones 6 to 9.

## Nandina domestica 'GULFSTREAM'

A standard in the industry, 'Gulfstream' is one of the best compact shrubs for year-round interest. Features bronze to green foliage, that turns brilliant red in fall, with a bushy, compact habit. Very tolerant of urban conditions. 4'H x 5'W. USDA zones 6 to 9.

Light, airy green in summer; brilliant scarlet red in winter. 4'H x 5'W. USDA zones 6 to 9.

### Nandina domestica 'HARBOUR DWARF'

Foliage appears dense because leaves are closely spaced on stems. Dark green, sometimes bluish, compound leaves appear very airy and lacy, and go to burgundy in the fall and winter. 2'H x 4'W. USDA zones 6 to 10.

#### Nandina domestica 'FIRE POWER'

New growth is lime green, and ages to light-to-medium green. Foliage may be tinged with yellow or red in summer, with outer leaves turning burgundy to brilliant red in the fall and winter. 2'H x 3'W. USDA zones 6 to 10.

### Nandina domestica 'Jaytee' HARBOR BELLE™

PP #14,668. Soft, dense foliage tinged with pink in the spring, matures to a dark green, then turns brilliant burgundy in the fall and winter. Clusters of tiny white flowers in spring, lead to an abundance of bright red berries. Compact habit. 2'H x 2'W. USDA zones 6 to 11.

### Nandina domestica 'BURGUNDY WINE'

Vibrant red and green foliage in the spring, turns red in the fall. Evergreen leaves are narrower and finer in texture than other cultivars of the species. Creamy white flowers rise above the foliage mid to late spring, followed by white berries from early fall to late winter. 3'H x 3'. USDA zones 6 to 9.
