Rhododendron 'Capistrano'

While yellow cultivars are less common than the more typical reds, whites, purples and pinks of most rhododendrons, if you are looking to add a touch of golden warmth to your garden, Rhododendron 'Capistrano' will do nicely. A sunny variety that produces a profusion of frilly, greenish-yellow, trumpet-shaped flowers, in large, rounded trusses of up to fifteen blossoms, 'Capistrano' is hardy and relatively low maintenance, if somewhat particular about its soil conditions. Plant 'Capistrano' in areas of full sun to partial shade, in acidic soil that is welldrained and high in organic matter. Its narrow evergreen foliage is dark green, and creates a dense, compact mound that is disease and pest resistant. 'Capistrano' makes an excellent addition as an accent plant or a stand-alone specimen in your garden, and makes a stunning display when planted en masse.

- Hardy to zone 5
- Compact, dense, mounding habit; 4'H x 4'W at 10 years
- Full sun to part shade
- Moist, well-drained soil that is high in organic matter
- Water regularly in hot, dry weather
- Glossy, dark green, evergreen foliage
- Dome shaped trusses with up to 15 flowers in spring
- Greenish-yellow, frilly, trumpet-shaped blooms
- Disease and pest resistant
