**Parentage:** *R. williamsianum* hybrid; introduced by Ken Cox

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 7

**Size:** 2'H x 2.5'W at 10 years

**Habit:** Slow growing, compact, rounded shrub

**Culture:** Dappled shade; well drained, organic soil

- Rounded, shiny, black-red leaves fade to dark green
- Waxy, deep red, bell-shaped flowers April-May; loose truss
- Best used as small space specimen in container or ground; smaller spaces en masse; border or foundation planting
