

VACCINIUM VITIS-IDAEA

Koralle

a.k.a.
Lingonberry,
Mountain Cranberry,
Cowberry, or
Foxberry

More commonly known as Lingonberry, *Vaccinium vitis-idaea* 'Koralle' was developed in Germany. Its small, glossy, evergreen leaves take on a mahogany hue during the Winter months. Near white to pink flowers bloom from Spring to Fall, followed by bright red,

edible berries. Plant 'Koralle' in full sun for optimal berry production. 'Koralle' naturalizes well, is resistant to deer and rabbits, and is self-pollinating, making it an excellent choice for use in borders, mixed containers, or as a groundcover.



- Hardy to USDA Zone 2 to 7
- 1'H x 1.5'W at ten years
- Fruiting, spreading, evergreen groundcover
- Plant in full sun for best berry production
- Acidic, moist, but well drained soil that is rich in organic matter
- Small, glossy, smooth evergreen leaves
- Near white, to pink flowers Spring to Fall
- Bright red berries that are excellent for eating or cooking
