

This brand new blueberry cultivar, introduced by the USDA-ARS, blends the best of the North and South. Get it first at Briggs Nursery!

vaccinium 'Nocturne' PP#24,832, so named because of the dusky black color of its ripe fruit, is a hybrid of the northern highbush with the faster-growing and productive rabbit eye. The result is a cultivar that combines the winter hardiness of blueberries grown in the northern U.S., with the vigorous growth of southern varieties. Its medium to large black berries are sweet, with a flavor that is not typical of rabbit eye or highbush varieties. Nocturne's glossy green foliage and eye-popping, vivid coral unripe berries make it an attractive ornamental addition to any garden.

Fruit: Medium to large; dusky black when ripe; vivid coral when unripe; reliably produces fruit mid to late season (approx. 12-13 lbs.)

Habit: Upright, slightly sprawling

Sun: Full to part sun

Soil: Well-drained, acidic soil
