MAGNOLIA GENIE'S

compact, densely-branched, slender habit make it a perfect addition to smaller gardens. In the early spring, Genie's bare, upright branches are covered with masses of striking, black-red buds, that unfurl slowly into rounded, tulip-shaped blooms. Once open, large, subtly-fragranced flowers glow, in shades of deepest burgundy to ruby red, with reflexed tips of lighter magenta. The first and heaviest flush of blooms lasts from spring to mid-summer, when a second, lighter flush appears among leathery, green foliage, if provided with ample water and full sun.

- Compact, slender, densely-branched, pyramidal habit; mature size 10'H x 5'W
- Very floriferous, repeat summer bloomer
- 6-inch, cupped flowers are deep burgundy to ruby red, with reflexed magenta tips
- Deciduous, leathery, dark green foliage
- Frost resistant to 37°F (3°C); USDA 5-9
