



Yucca filamentosa x pallida
'Silver Anniversary' PP#31,437

A 2018 Plant Delights/JLBG introduction, Yucca 'Silver Anniversary' is hybridized from two American soapwort species, Yucca filamentosa and Yucca pallida. The wide, dusty blue leaves of 'Silver Anniversary', with curling white filaments along the margins, form a vigorous 2'H x 4'W, fast-offsetting clump. In mid-May, flower spikes, up to 7-feet tall, rise from the center of each clump, emerging burgundy, then opening to reveal panicles of creamy white, nodding, bell-shaped flowers. 'Silver Anniversary' presents a truly unique and beautiful picture in the landscape.

- 2'H x 4'W; flower spike 7'H
- USDA Zone 5b to 10b
- Plant in well-drained soil
- Drought and salt tolerant
- Full to part sun
- Attracts pollinators

YUCCA

Notable for their rosettes of thick, sword-shaped leaves, and large terminal panicles of creamy flowers, Yucca are native to the hot and arid regions of the Americas, and some islands of the Caribbean. They are widely grown as ornamental and architectural plants, providing dramatic interest to garden and landscape designs.

Yucca are evergreen, drought resistant, and very forgiving when it comes to soil type, as long as it is well-drained. Pollinators love the tall spikes of drooping, bell-shaped flowers that appear from late spring to summer.
